

# Beers

## Belgian Brews

**Delirium Tremens - 8.5% abv** 7.00

Big body, rich mouth feel, and a long sweet aftertaste. "The first sip warms my throat & belly like a woodstove does a log cabin." –Stuart Kallen

**Delirium Nocturnum - 8.5% abv** 7.00

Medium bodied with a hints of chocolate in the nose. Earthy hops, chocolate and praline up front, with brown sugar and slight yeastiness on the finish.

**Duvel Golden Ale - 8.5% abv** 6.00

Bottle conditioned. Combines Pilsner malts, Bohemian hops, and a unique yeast strain to create an intensely aromatic and beguiling ale.

**Foret Saison Ale (750 ml) - 7.5% abv** 11.75

Organic; Originally brewed for farm hands as a reward for a season of hard work. Recognizable yeast character, a fruit palate with a dry finish. - 96 pts. RB

**Hoegaarden - 5% abv** 5.50

Naturally cloudy and shimmering, Hoegaarden is a surprising beer with a heritage dating back to 1445. A smooth beer with spicy nose of orange peel and coriander. A preferred thirst quencher.

**La Chouffe Golden Ale (750 ml) - 8% abv** 12.00

An unfiltered blonde beer, which is re-fermented in the bottle as well as in the keg. Pleasantly fruity, spiced with coriander, and finishes with a light hop taste.

**Houblon Chouffe Dobbelen IPA Tripel (750 ml) - 9% abv** 12.00

This "Indian Pale Ale" type of beer exudes harmonious balance between marked bitterness (three types of hops are used) and a pleasant fruitiness, again re-fermented in the bottle.

# Trappist Ales

In order to be called 'Trappist' the beers are made in a brewery controlled and occupied by Benedictine Monks.

**Chimay Grand Reserve (750 ml) - 9% abv** **14.50**

This beer offers fresh yeast with a light, flowery rose touch, revealing a light but pleasant hint of roasted malt.

**Orval - 6.9% abv** **9.50**

An intensely aromatic and dry character. Between the first and second fermentations there is also an additional dry-hopping process. - 98 pts RB

**Rochefort 8 - 9.2% abv** **9.50**

Dark brown colored body with a off white head a nice fruity aroma a nice fruity caramel taste and a nice average bitter fruity alcoholic finish. - 100 pts RB

**Rochefort 10 - 11.2% abv** **11.00**

Aroma isn't particularly strong, but very good with lots of dark fruits. Taste is more of the same with some cola and chocolate rounding it out. - 100 pts RB

**Westmalle Dubbel - 7% abv** **8.50**

A reddish brown trappist ale, malty and fruit, featuring a 3 week secondary fermentation. - 98 pts RB

**Westmalle Tripel - 9.5% abv** **8.50**

A strong, dry and spicy trappist ale. The product of a secondary fermentation lasting 5 weeks. - 96 pts RB

# Unibroue

Hailing from Quebec Canada, these beers are brewed with an age old process similar to Méthode Champenoise giving their "belgian-style" ales uniqueness.

**Blanche de Chambly - 5% abv** **6.00**

Canadian wheat and pale barley malts make up this lightly fruity, spicy and citrusy beer. Meant to be a throwback beer - how far back? Think of what people in the Middle Ages were drinkin' and this was probably their style.

**Don De Dieu - 9% abv** **6.00**

Triple wheat ale. Smooth, rich and creamy. Ideal with meats and cheeses. - 94 pts  
RB

**La Fin Du Monde - 9% abv** **6.00**

Triple fermentation. Balanced flavors of wild spice, malts & hops. Brewed in honor of the great explorers who believed they had reached the "end of the world," when discovering America.

**Maudite, Strong Red Ale - 8% abv** **6.00**

A spicy aroma with flavors of subtle coriander, light spices and a hint of hops.

**Trois Pistoles, Strong Dark Ale - 9% abv** **6.00**

Dusty black in color with aromas of ripe fruit and chocolate. Wild fruit and port merry on the palate.

**Ephemere - 5.5% abv** **5.00**

A perfect accompaniment for tapas, cream and light cheeses as well as any apple or pear desserts.

## German Weissbiers

- Hacker Pschorr Weiss; Germany (16 oz) - 5.5% abv** 5.75  
High in effervescence, low in calories, with a uniquely crisp refreshing fruity and clovey finish.
- Konig Ludwig Weiss; Bavaria, Germany - 5.5% abv** 5.00  
Well balanced with malty overtones; has an aroma reminiscent of apples and bananas.
- Michael Plank Bavarian Heller Weizenbock (500 ml) - 7.5% abv** 7.75  
A testament to the master brewer Michael Plank. Light in style but still packing a punch. A light floral nose with big flavors of spice and banana.
- Weihenstephaner Krystal or Dunkel Germany (16.9 oz) - 5.3% ab** 5.50  
Each swig has your buds wailing for more. Peppery nose with the slightest hints of strawberry and banana.

## Pilsners & Lagers From Around the World

- Brooklyn Lager; New York - 5% abv** 4.75  
Amber Gold in color, and displays a firm malt center supported by a floral hop bitterness.
- Great Lakes Elliot Ness Amber Lager; Cleveland, OH - 6.2% abv** 5.00  
A sunny golden lager with a mild hop profile and slightly malty flavor. This sociable lager is the perfect thirst quencher.
- Great Lakes Dortmunder; Cleveland, OH - 5.8% abv** 5.00  
A smooth lager that strikes a delicate balance sweet malt and dry hop flavors. Gold Medal Winner 2007 World Beer Cup as well as '98, '99, '00, '01, 02, and '04.
- Pacifico Clara; Mexico - 4.6% abv** 5.00  
Brewed in Mazatlan and known for its brilliant pale gold color and full flavored taste. Must be tried by seafood lovers.
- Pilsner Urquell; Czech Republic - 4.4% abv** 5.00  
Begins with taste of Saaz hops which blends with the malty sweetness to produce a clean taste.
- Sapporo; Japan (22 oz) - 4.7% abv** 6.25  
Draft can. Nice balance, crisp and clean.

# American Ales

- Arcadia IPA; Battle Creek, MI - 5.9% abv** 4.75  
Highest ranked American IPA in the 1998 World Beer Championship.
- Bells Two Hearted IPA; Kalamazoo, MI - 7% abv** 4.25  
India Pale Ale style. American malts and enormous hop additions give this beer a crisp finish and an incredible floral hopped aroma.
- Breckenridge 471 Double IPA; Colorado - 9.2% abv** 5.00  
Small Batch limited edition ale. Big sweet mouth feel, balanced by aggressive hoppiness.
- Dogfish Head 60 Minute IPA; Milton, Delaware - 6% abv** 4.50  
Dogfish Head's flagship beer. A favorite at Bar Divani. A floral IPA with notes of citrus, cedar, pine and candied oranges. Pairs well with spicy foods, pesto, grilled salmon and pizza.
- Bells Porter; Kalamazoo, MI - 5.6% abv** 4.25  
A robust beer for all occasions. A blend of dark malts give this beer flavors of coffee and chocolate with subtle roasted notes.
- Breckenridge Vanilla Porter; Colorado - 4.7% abv** 5.00  
Deep brown in color with flavors of smooth roasted chocolate with a creamy vanilla finish. Real vanilla beans from New Guinea and Madagascar are added to make this a Divani favorite.
- Bells Kalamazoo Stout; Kalamazoo, MI - 6% abv** 4.25  
A full bodied stout with plenty of roast flavor. Flavors of coffee and chocolate with a surprising amount of hop taste for this very dark stout.
- Thirsty Dog, Siberian Night Russian Imperial Stout; Ohio - 9% abv** 4.50  
Designed for you tough gals and guys, this 9% abv doesn't mess about and its rich, decadent taste will overwhelm the masses.
- J & K Scrumpy's Hard Cider - 6% ab, 750 ml** 12.00  
A farmhouse cider made with yeast and juice, it's all about drinkability. All-Organic.
- Avery Brewing Company, Ellie's Brown Ale; Colorado - 5.5% abv** 5.00  
Crystal and chocolate malts give this beer a brown sugar maltiness with hints of vanilla and nuts, while subtle hopping gives it an overall drinkability.
- Bells Amber Ale; Kalamazoo, MI - 5.8% abv** 4.25  
Made from mostly pale malt with some Munich and caramel malts. Slightly sweet flavor that is balanced by American hops. Deep copper color and rich flavor.

**Founders Dirty Bastard Scotch Ale; Grand Rapids, MI - 8.3% abv** 5.00

Dirty Bastard is complex in the finish with hints of smoke and peat paired with a malty richness, finalized with a hoppy attitude. This beer "ain't fer the wee lads."

**Goose Island, Matilda, Belgian Pale Ale; Chicago, IL - 7% abv** 4.75

Wild in character, with a slightly fruity aroma and a spicy yeast flavor that is as unique as it is satisfying.

**Redhook Ale Brewery, ESB; Washington - 5.77% abv** 4.00

Rich, copper-colored ale styled by a complex balance between the bitterness of the hops and the sweetness of a heavier caramel malting. A late addition of hops highlights the fresh aroma.

## Dark Beers from Great Britain & Beyond

**Old Suffolk; Great Britain - 6.0% abv** 6.50

Strong vintage ale brewed to the maximum strength possible for a beer. The only beer in Great Britain left to mature 2 years in 100 barrel oak vats. 97 Pts.

**Young's Double Chocolate Stout; Great Britain (14.9 oz Pub Can) - 5** 5.75

Melted chocolate bars are added to give a distinctive chocolate taste with a velvety, smooth finish.

**Samuel Smith's Nut Brown; England - 5% abv** 6.25

Wonderful balance of roasted crystal malt, hazelnuts, and aromatic hops.

**Wexford Irish Cream Ale; England - 5% abv** 6.50

Smooth, sweet and creamy. Like sniffing a container of heavy cream. A sweet and grainy texture with mild bitterness lingers on the palate.

**Skull Splitter Barleywine; Scotland - 8.5% abv** 6.00

Orkney strong ale with a distinctive flavor and a powerful kick, great with red meat, spicy food and especially chocolate. 93 Pts.

**Lion Stout; Sri Lanka - 8% abv** 5.50

Taste is creamy and big with hints of malted coffee and chocolate. A big body feel that creamily coats everything inside the mouth.

**Celebrator; Bavaria - 6.7% abv** 6.00

Bavarian doppelbock. Profoundly dark, rich elixir with a complex fruitiness of roasted malt and whole hop flowers with a semi-dry finish (and a cute little goat.) 98 Pts.
